ONEONTA CONCERT ASSOCIATION HISTORY

Representatives from New York City's Community Concerts came to Oneonta to discuss plans for bringing quality concerts to cities and towns throughout the U.S. The year was 1928 and the first concert in Oneonta was on February 13, 1929. Hundreds of excellent programs have followed, and the Association is still managed by community volunteers from the area. Income from subscription sales, a major source of revenue, allows OCA to begin and complete the current season and plan for the following season's concerts.

Part of the mission of OCA is to provide informative presentations for students and the general community in connection with our concerts. In 2011-2012, OCA will offer student outreach with pianist Rossano Sportiello and the Taylor 2 Dance Company.
